He is a distinguished life member (1991) of the New York State Veterinary Medical Society, for which he served as president (1982) and centennial chairman (1990); he was named Veterinarian of the Year by NYSVMS in 1987. He served on the New York State Board for Veterinary Medicine (1984-94).
