FIND IT--- Locating E-Books

- **Library Catalog**

<http://catalog.library.cornell.edu> (Classic Catalog)

or *WorldCat Local Catalog*

Includes all e-books licensed or selected for Cornell community

Search by author, title, or subject keyword

Follow links to publisher/vendor web site

Note: Some links connect to online tables-of-contents only

On left again, choose a Filter, such as “Books”

Includes approx. 5,000 of Cornell Vet Library’s books and journals, incl. *Cornell Veterinarian*, digitized by Google; viewable if permitted by copyright

- **Internet Archive: Digital Library of Free Books, Movies, Music, etc.**

Includes pre-1923 veterinary titles and free, open access titles

Includes “Biodiversity Heritage Library” natural history titles

Includes approx. 4,000 of Cornell Vet Library’s pre-1923 public domain books digitized by Microsoft.

USE IT --- viewing, downloading, printing

E-book views and functions depend the vendor or platform (e.g., MyLibrary, eBrary, NetLibrary, Ebsco, etc.)

Chapter pdfs on publisher web sites; view, save, print as needed
Elsevier, Wiley-Blackwell, Springer
